The new lower odour solvent dissipates faster from the living area for a more comfortable living environment, and of course the 50% faster dry time means you can get the job done more quickly, enabling you to get back on with life!

If you've used **CFP** in the past on your floors, but the smooth shine and richness that enhanced your floors isn't quite so fresh any more, you can rejuvenate the finish with new CFP - it's easy. Follow the instructions on the can, and you can complete your floor top-coating project in just one day.

CFP is available in two sheen levels (gloss and satin). For accelerated hardness and wear resistance use Cabot's **CFP High Wear Accelerator** to speed up the curing process and give extra protection to the floor and coating, faster.

WHAT MAKES THIS FORMULA SO MUCH TOUGHER?

Solvent based finishes like CFP give durable, hard wearing results, enhancing the natural rich, warm tone of timber. New CFP now uses a unique blend of resins that give a 40% tougher finish than before, making the coating even more resistant to scuffing and scratching.

WHY IS 'LOWER ODOUR' A BENEFIT?

A lower odour formula is ideal when coating large areas in the home, like flooring, where the smell can linger for long periods. CFP's lower odour solvent dissipates faster, leaving a less noticeable odour in a shorter period of time while still guaranteeing the same durable product performance.

AND FASTER DRYING?

When you are disrupting your life to do your floors, being able to move back in sooner is ideal - CFP's faster re-coat times mean you can apply subsequent coats quickly and finish the job in half the time.

Hints for a DIAMOND TOUGH finish



1 APPLY LIKE A PROFESSIONAL
Choose a premium grade brush for cutting in around the edges. Use a quality lambswool applicator, removing any loose fibres before use. Wash and allow the applicator to dry thoroughly **before** use - oil and water don't mix!



2 SANDING IS THE KEY
New timber floors must be sanded before coating, but did you know you can overcoat your existing CFP floor finish to revive and protect your timber? Lightly sand the floor* with a fine grade paper or screen back disk, remove any dust before coating, and you've rejuvenated the floor! For a superior finish, de-nib between coats with 320-400 grade sand paper to remove any grain raise or imperfections in the coating.



3 A TOUGHER, FASTER FINISH
New CFP is up to **40%** tougher, 8 weeks after application, but when you want your floors traffic ready fast, use Cabot's CFP High Wear Accelerator in each coat to speed up the curing process. CFP increases in strength another **85%** in 8 weeks with the use of High Wear Accelerator, compared to using CFP alone.

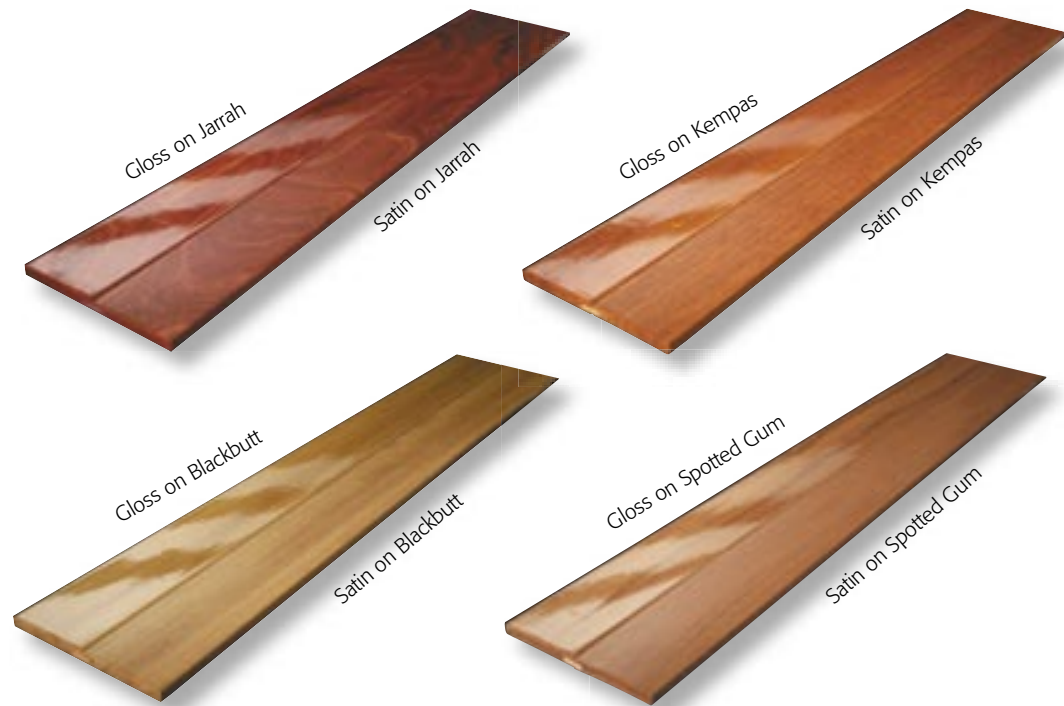
